TRANSIT GUIDE

Etiquette for Riding the Bus

BOARDING

- ✓ Plan your route in advance
- ✓ Arrive at your stop or station a few minutes before
- ✓ When the bus arrives, check the route number and destination on the front of the bus before boarding, or by listening to the driver as the doors open
- ✓ Wait for passengers to exit
- ✓ Enter through the front door and pay your fare at the fare box

TAKE A SEAT

- ✓ Leave the seats at the front of the bus and near doors available for seniors and people with disabilities
- ✓ Keep your belongings in your lap, arms, or between your feet
- ✓ Stay awake and alert
- ✓ If standing, hold a bar or straps while the bus or train is moving
- ✓ Avoid frequently changing seats or moving from the front to the back of the bus repeatedly

REQUEST A STOP

- ✓ To alert the driver to stop at the next stop, pull the yellow cord or push the stop request button one time
- ✓ Avoid repeatedly pressing or pulling the stop request signal
- ✓ If you are not sure where your stop is, politely ask the driver
