What We Are Seeing Nationally

- Bipartisan Infrastructure Law/
Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act reaffirms federal commitment to SRTS
- SRTS programs persevere, but many new people
- Leaning into partnerships
 - Libraries
 - Academic institutions
 - Youth-led organizations



Federal Funding Opportunities for Safe Routes to School

- RAISE – December 2023
 - Large infrastructure projects
 - Philadelphia school zone traffic safety project- \$25mil
- Safe Streets and Roads for All – Spring 2024
 - Planning, demonstration projects, and implementation
 - Costa Mesa Safe Routes to School Action Plan - \$630k
 - La Habra Safe Routes to School Action Plan - \$320k
- Promising new programs:
 - Active Transportation Investment Program
 - Neighborhood Equity and Access grants




State Funding Opportunities

- Active Transportation Program (ATP)
 - Cycle 7 anticipated spring 2024
 - Apply for our free technical assistance by August 31

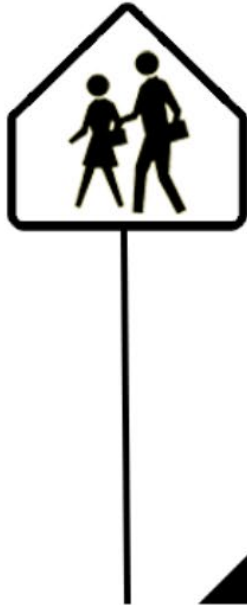
